For Autumn Term: June 10th (23:59h)

For Spring Term: September 10th (23:59h)

Student **APPLICATIONS** must reach the receiving institution by:

For Autumn Term: July 10th (23:59h)

For Spring Term: October 10th (23:59h)

Applications received after deadline will be rejected.

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENTS' MOBILITY

B1 level is recommended in Catalan, the main teaching language. Language competence development is available and advised before your stay. You can use this platform to improve your Catalan language skills:

During your stay, and as part of the Learning Agreement, further Catalan language competence development is available for 3 ECTS credits per term (45 presential hours per term), and mandatory when needed to meet language level needs. **This option must be requested at the time of application.**

At the teacher's discretion, other languages may be agreed upon between the student and the teacher for individual support and tuition.

Other languages: Some subjects are held in English (Singing I and Theatre in English Language). B1 level is required. Spanish Diction is held in Spanish (B2 level required, given the specificity of the subject).
